



# 10618NAT Course in Firearms Safety (approved for Firearms Licensing in Queensland)

## WHO NEEDS TO DO THIS COURSE

Under Queensland Legislation, all persons applying for a firearms license must complete a safety course from an approved training organisation. The safety course must be completed in the 12 month period prior to the date of when you wish to lodge your application for a License.

The training covers:

- ✓ Legislation
- ✓ Social Responsibility
- ✓ General Safety
- ✓ Specific test on chosen Category of Firearms
- ✓ Live firing practical component.

## COURSE INFORMATION

The course is facilitated by a Licensed Firearms Instructor. The course deals with knowledge, attitude and behaviours needed to use a firearm safely, responsibly and legally. It includes the technology of firearms and ammunition, safe handling and safe use of firearms, legal and social responsibilities of shooters, and practical shooting.

We offer training and assessment for -

- *Categories A & B*
- *Categories A, B & C*
- *Category C (A & B must be previously attained and current)*

Upon successful completion of the course you will be issued with a Statement of Attainment (you will receive the Statement of Attainment by mail within 21 days of completion of the course).

Course cost: \$110.00 for A & B; or \$160 for A, B & C  
Course times: 9a.m. to 3p.m.
